About the Vice-Chair Program

Thank you for your interest in acting as a student Vice-Chair of the Mexican American Bar Association of Los Angeles County ("MABA"). Per MABA's Bylaws, each year MABA's President appoints a local Latinx law student to serve as the Student Trustee on MABA's Board of Trustees.

To engage Latinx law students at all local law schools, MABA will appoint two Latinx students to act as Co Vice-Chairs at each local law school. The responsibilities of Vice-Chair include: promoting and disseminating information about MABA events to Latinx law students, as well as volunteering (when practicable) at MABA events. When volunteering at MABA events, Student Vice-Chairs are to act within MABA's Code of Ethics before, during, and after the event. Student Vice-Chairs are also encouraged to participate in MABA's Law Student, Attorney, and Judicial Officer Mentorship Program, and encourage other Latinx law students to do the same.

MABA will also require Co Vice-Chairs to attend one MABA Board meeting during the year to provide a presentation about your school's Raza chapter (or organizational equivalent). The position is open to current 1L and 2L students, with preference for second-year students. Returning Vice-Chairs who are currently 3L students or will be entering their 3L year in the Fall of 2022 are encouraged to apply/return to the role. All applications will be considered.
